## PUPPY CONTRACT

Puppies are not televisions. They are not manufactured in a plant or assembly line. They cannot be tested in a laboratory, or inspected for quality. They are living animals, created through two other living animals, none of which are perfect. The only thing we as breeders can do is to be selective when breeding to try to prevent this puppy from acquiring hereditary faults however, due to the unknown genetic and environmental causes of such faults, this puppy is sold AS IS and no guarantee is given. Bad things can and do happen to good dogs. This is why no guarantee of such is or can be made or intended herein. We try as breeders, but there is so much that the individual who has the pup contributes to the success and health of the puppy. As a new puppy owner, you need to learn what activities are appropriate for a puppy, what food will contribute to proper growth, proper training and what the necessary veterinary care is. These are issues the new owner is responsible for investigating, they are important because they contribute to the lasting health of your dog.

Your Labrador Retriever has been bred from temperamentally sound parents. The puppy is expected to be free of hereditary crippling hip & elbow dysplasia. However, no health guarantee of any type can be made or intended herein. Except for the fact that the puppy has been examined by a veterinarian and received a state of NH Health certificate by the time of sale and has had the immunizations in the veterinary health certificate/ record you receive on pick up day.

When you pick up your puppy, it will have been examined by a veterinarian, and has been inoculated with the appropriate vaccinations. This puppy also has a state of NH veterinary health certificate. The puppy has been treated for parasites.

It is understood that, by the time of sale, this puppy has been evaluated by a veterinarian with respect to other representatives of the breed at approximately the same age dog. This does not necessarily imply that the dog is of breeding or show quality. To insure this, guarantee the buyer must have the puppy examined by a veterinarian of their choice within 14 days of purchase. If the puppy is found to be ill, the breeder is to be notified by phone call and text (NOT e-mail) and please keep trying till you have reached me or I respond So we know your message was not missed for any reason. If the puppy fails to receive veterinarian clearance for any reason other than direct or indirect actions of the new owners care or lack of care in any way or (abuse, trauma, etc.). The dog may be returned within 20 days for a full refund of purchase price, providing the following is met: the return of the puppy and all papers to the breeder, including a written statement from the attending veterinarian stating the puppies' condition & all veterinary records. No veterinary or shipping cost or any other expenses will be reimbursed. After the 20-day full refund, if for any reason I decide to give any type of refund or money payment it will never exceed half the price of the pup or cover any other expenses of any type.

**SPAY/NEUTER, AND REGISTRATION STATUS:**

The buyer, in the interest of maintaining quality in the Labrador breed, agrees to the following: In the interests of protecting the Labrador breed and not contributing unnecessarily to the problem of pet overpopulation, the breeder is selling this puppy when requested on AKC Limited Registration. AKC Limited Registration when registration papers are requested on pick up day, must be requested by this day (you always get a copy of the parent's pedigree) AKC Limited Registration means that this dog is registered but no litters produced by the dog are eligible for AKC Registration. This puppy is sold as a "PET PUP" and must be spayed/neutered by 18 months old at your expense by your veterinarian.

**RETURN AGREEMENT:**

The buyer agrees that if he/she is unable to keep this Labrador Retriever, he/she will not give dog to pound or similar situation or otherwise dispose of this dog without first contacting the breeder, who will either accept the dog on a return basis or assist the buyer in finding a suitable alternative home for the dog. This does not imply a financial commitment on the part of the breeder. We can help give the pup or dog away rather than having it go to a pound. We do understand things happen people relocate, divorce, allergies etc.

**OTHER PROVISIONS:**

The buyer agrees to provide a suitable environment for this dog and will not allow it to run loose in an unsupervised situation. Pups are like children they need constant supervision and discipline. Puppy schools are a must to attend; you now have a ball of clay that needs molding. You will only get out of your pup, what you put into it. The more time you put in a pup, the better dog you will have later in life.

Buyer agrees to spay or neuter this pup before 2 years of age, and notify breeder if ever placing the dog with another person or return the pup to the breeder to find a home for the pup.

The buyer agrees to keep this dog current on the required immunizations and any type of health care, and be responsible for all veterinary fees once they take possession of this pup. Buyer agrees to take proper care of the dog and not breed this dog. If any litters or pups result from this dog they become the property of Integrity Farm, Brenda Mazzaglia and an additional fee of \$5,000.00 will be charged per litter. So basically, all you have to do is spay or neuter the pup before 2 years and keep a good eye until then and there will be no problem...

The Buyer agrees to keep the puppy in appropriate good weight so as to maximize the puppy/dog's soundness and longevity. The Buyer agrees to socialize, train and keep the puppy in a schooled manner.

*Reasonable precautions have been taken to prevent this puppy from acquiring hereditary faults such as hip dysplasia, elbow dysplasia, eye conditions, etc., however, due to the unknown genetic and environmental causes of such faults, this puppy is sold AS IS and no guarantee is given.*

By signing this contract below, you are saying; you agree to contract 2 the Payment and Pick up Schedule, and you follow it as it reads. The deposits are non-refundable and not transferable. And that you understand the payment schedule and pick up schedule.

No verbal agreement will over ride this contract. Deposits are Non-refundable.
